
CHAPTER 128. SPEED OF VESSELS ON CASS RIVER

9.230. Finding of Fact. The City Council finds and declares that it is in the public interest and public welfare to regulate the speed of vessels on a portion of the Cass River in the City of Frankenmuth.

9.231. Definitions. When used in this Chapter, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

- (1) Vessel means every description of watercraft, other than a seaplane on the water, used or capable of being used as a means of transportation on water.
- (2) Slow--No Wake Speed means a very slow speed whereby the wake or wash created by the vessel would be minimal.

9.232. Slow--No Wake Zone Established. On the waters of the Cass River, from a line two hundred (200) feet upstream from the Memorial Park Boat Launch to the dam, west of the Main Street Bridge, all within the City of Frankenmuth, Saginaw County, it is unlawful for the operator of a vessel to exceed a slow--no wake speed.

The boundaries of the area described immediately above shall be marked with signs and with buoys. All buoys must be placed as provided in a permit issued by the Department of Natural Resources and be in conformance with the State Uniform Waterway Marking System.

9.233. Violation; Misdemeanor. A person who violates any provision of this Chapter shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable as provided by Sections 1.12(1) and (2) of this Code.
